ARRIVAL/ADDIS ABABA TO WENDOGENET</p> <p>Arrival in Addis Ababa then Addis Ababa to Wendogenet. On the way, visit the northernmost Rift Valley Lake-Lake Zeway for its bird species. Up on arrival in Wendogenet, spot so many forest birds like Silver Chicked Horn Bill. O/N. Hotel</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-02. DRIVE TO DINSHO</p> <p>Drive to the Bale Mt. National Park, traveling thorough the southeast part of the capital. We arrive at Dinsho, the Park♦s head quarter. Around the head quarter spot so many bird and wild animals including an endemic Menelik's Bushbuck, and Mountain Nyala. O/N. at Dinsho Lodge O/N. at Dinsho Lodge</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-03. GAYSAY VALLEY</p> <p>The whole day visit around Dinsho and Geysay Valley. In time hike to see three of the endemic mammals: Menelik's Bushbuck, Mountain Nyala and Ethiopian wolf. The rest of the day arranges the trekking staff. O/N. Dinsho lodge</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-04. SENATTE PLATO.</p> <p>Make an excursion tip to Senatte plato thru the afro alpine vegetation. Ascend the peak of the Senate. Throw your sight to spot an endemic Semen Fox. Back to Dinsho. O/N. Camp/Lodge</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-05. DRIVE TO AWASSA.</p> <p>Drive to Awassa- regional capital city for Southern Nations and Nationalities People Region; for an overnight stay. O/N. Hotel</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-06. FISH MARKET THEN ARBA MINCH</p> <p>Walk around the fish market located at the shore of Lake Awassa and spot different bird species like Pelicans, Hamerkob, Ibises ♦drive to Arba Minch. O/N. Hotel</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-07. DORZE VILLAGE AND LAKE CHAMO</p> <p>Scenic drive to the mountain village of Chencha, home for Dorze tribes-renowned weavers. Pm. boat trip on Lake Chamo to visit Crocodile market and Hippo farm.</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-08. TO TURMI</p> <p>Drive to Turmi. On the way Konso, Tsemay, Weito and Erbore tribes. Visit Hamer tribes who are famous by their Bull jumping ceremony and Evangadi dance. O/N. Lodge/Camping. DAY-09. KARO & TURMI MARKET Karo tribes and Turmi Hamer tribes market. O/N. Camping.</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-10 DRIVE TO JINKA</p> <p>Drive to Jinka via Dimeka Tue/Sat market for Hamer tribes, and Key Afer-Thu market for Bena and Tsemay tribes. O/N. Hotel/Camping</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-11 MURSI TRIBES</p> <p>A.m. Visit the clay lip plated Mursi tribes, P.M. Jinka and visit Jinka Ethnographic Museum. O/N. Hotel/Camping</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-12. JINKA/ARBA MINCH</p> <p>Drive to Arba Minch. Weito, Tsemay village, Konso♦s King♦s Village. O/N. Hotel</p> <p class="tour_module_title">DAY-13.
